



The Benefits of Boardgames

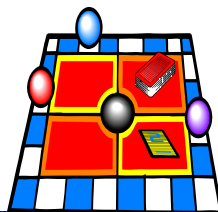
Research has proven children who play board games have better math skills in life. The more games a preschooler knew the better their skills were in:

- Understanding concept of number magnitude (greater and less than)

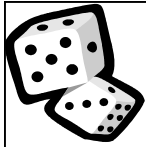
