Routine Schedule for MMR, Varicella and MMRV

Routine and catch-up schedules for children 12 months of age and older who are on time with their vaccinations

Two doses - one at 12 months and one at 18 months	One dose at 15 months	-	4 to 6 years If older than 4 years, give varicella at current visit if born on January 1, 2000 or afterward or high risk	-

Minimum intervals between vaccines not given on the same day

Vaccines regardless of which vaccine is given first	Recommended minimum interval between doses (for vaccines not given on the same day)
MMR and MMR	4 weeks
MMR and Varicella	4 weeks
MMR and MMRV	6 weeks
MMRV and MMRV	6 weeks
Varicella and Varicella	3 months if 1 to 12 years of age inclusive 6 weeks if 13 years of age or older
Varicella and MMRV	3 months
