## Reducing Your Waste

An easy way to reduce the amount of hazardous waste you create, is to simply use fewer hazardous products.

### Remember the **BUD** rule:

- B** Buy only as much as you will need
- U** Use it all up
- D** Dispose of what is left properly

*From the decision to purchase a product to consideration of disposal or recycling, every small effort makes a big difference.*

***If you don't need it, don't buy it!***

***Read the label and warnings*** - buy products without hazardous chemicals and dispose of products containing hazardous chemicals properly.

## Handling Precautions

- Waste should be brought to the depot in its original container
- Sharps and syringes must be brought to the depot in a rigid plastic container
- Do not mix waste products together
