



County of Huron Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Improvements at the Intersection of County Road 83 and Airport Line

Notice of Study Completion

The Project: The County of Huron initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) to investigate and evaluate improvements options at the intersection of County Road 83 and Airport Line, west of Exeter (see map). A traffic study identified the intersection currently operates at a Level of Service (LOS) of D, resulting in delays for turning movements and indicated the intersection is approaching capacity. Under future traffic levels, the LOS is expected to decrease. Given traffic volumes and concerns regarding accidents, the County examined potential improvements and as a result of the review of alternatives **is proposing to install a roundabout at the intersection.**

The Environmental Assessment Process: The project followed the MCEA process set out for Schedule 'B' activities. The purpose of the MCEA is to evaluate solutions related to infrastructure needs and projects following a logical and defined decision-making process. The process incorporated the evaluation of alternative solutions, potential environmental impacts, consultation, and identified how impacts may be mitigated.
