

**EIGHTH SESSION MINUTES  
COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF HURON**

Goderich, Ontario  
July 6, 2016

The Council of the County of Huron met in the Council Chambers on Wednesday, July 6, 2016. Warden Paul Gowing called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
