Household Incomes	Maximum Household Incomes	January 2013

PURPOSE:

The Service Manager can set a local rule regarding the maximum income of a household to be eligible for Rent-Geared-to-Income assistance.

The maximum income for a unit specified in the local eligibility rule must be at least the household income limit prescribed, under Ontario Regulation 370/11 (High Needs Households and Household Income Limits – Subsection 40 (4) of the Act) made under the Act, for such a unit.

HOUSING SERVICES ACT:

A Service Manager may make a local eligibility rule requiring, for a household to be eligible for rent-geared-to-income assistance, that the income of the household not exceed a specified maximum income (367/11 s. 34).

POLICY:

The maximum household income for Rent-Geared-to-Income eligibility is equivalent to the Household Income Limits found in Schedule 2 of Ontario Regulation 370/11, Housing Services Act, 2011, Subsection 40 (4) – High Needs Households and Household Income Limits.
