wander or become lost.

Individuals living with Alzheimer,
Dementia, Autism, Acquired Brain
Injury, Downs syndrome or other
cognitive disorders.

These individuals wear a lightweight
transmitter which emits a radio signal
that can be located up to 2 km away
by specially trained OPP officers
using mobile locating equipment.

If the person is missing, the caregiver
calls 911 immediately.

PROJECT LIFESAVER HUURON

- Participants must live in Huron County
- A caregiver lives with them and agrees to test the battery daily and complete the paperwork
- The caregiver agrees to call 911 every time the person goes missing
- All equipment remains the property of Huron County Paramedic Services
- Set up fee \$400 plus \$10/month for battery/wristband changes or a monthly payment plan of \$43.32. **The set up fee may be waived; please call us to discuss.**

Use of this equipment is not a substitute for responsible caregiving, nor does it guarantee a successful outcome if a person is reported missing.
