Huron Clean Water Project Project Requirements

Special / Demonstration Projects

Cost-share Rate: Up to 50% Maximum Payment: \$3,000

Purpose:

1. Occasionally innovative projects are proposed which do not fit into any of the Clean Water Project categories. The Special Projects category is proposed to offer assistance for new projects if they are able to demonstrate improved water quality and/or are accessible to the public.

Eligible Projects:

- 1. Must be able to demonstrate water quality improvements.
- 2. The Clean Water Project encourages new projects. Projects will be considered by the Review Committee if the invoice is not older than 6 months at the time first contact with staff.

Project Details:

- 1. Special project grants can complement a project that is eligible for another Clean Water Project category.
- 2. All appropriate permits as required by the appropriate agency will be obtained at the applicant's expense.
- 3. Costs above and beyond a basic project that are required to assist members of the public learn about and gain access to the project.
- 4. The Project Review Committee may restrict multiple applications to HCWP categories that are related to the same project.
- 5. Conservation Authorities and Municipalities are eligible for Clean Water Project funding.

Eligible Costs:

- 1. Licenced contractor fees
- 2. Materials and labour (other than applicant's or applicant's dependant)
- 3. Project design
- 4. Project monitoring
- 5. Costs above and beyond a basic project that are required to assist members of the public learn about and gain access to the project including signage, brochures and other materials that assist members of the public.
- 6. Items not covered in other Clean Water Project categories at the discretion of the Project Review Committee.

Ineligible costs:

- 1. Permits.
- 2. Grant will not be paid on HST if the applicant is entitled to a HST rebate.
