Specially trained staff who work directly with individuals in crisis, connecting them to the services and supports they require.



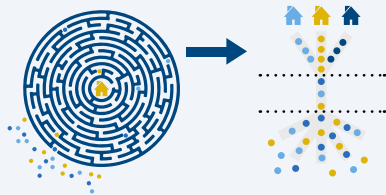
Communications

A *Huron County Homelessness Coordinated Access System* is currently under development.



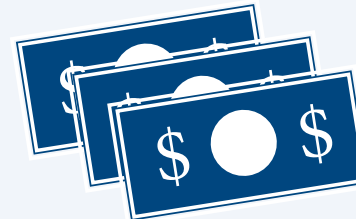
Homelessness Prevention
